- Beginner friendly, Ranked event
- Clocks with 60mins each will be used
- Allies and Withdraw rules will not be used
- Command Dice will not be used

Venue and Parking

The event will be held at Upstairs at Hatherley and Reddings Cricket Club, near Cheltenham. Their address is:

Ruleset

This event is a Ranked, Three Game 3rd Edition Kings of War Tournament, at 2300 points, using the Core Rule book (Big Red Book) with Clash of Kings 2025 updates, or Mantic Companion. All armies listed on the Mantic Companion will be permitted.

Optional rule for Allies will not be allowed.
Optional rule for Withdraw will not be used.
Optional rule for Command Dice **won't** be used.

Schedule and Timings

The event will comprise 3 games of Kings of War 3ed. Each game will be timed with a time limit of 60 mins per person permitted. Games are scheduled as below. Please endeavour to be as prompt as you can be to ensure that the day runs to plan. Players will need to provide a chess clock between them for each game. There are various free mobile applications available to provide this.

In the event of a players timing out the "dice down" approach will be used. The player that has run out of time will roll no further dice, move units etc but will not lose the game by default. Objectives, table sectors and loot tokens will still be scored. Their opponent may continue to play their full turn allocation including playing out a turn 7 if one becomes available.

Army Lists

Armies must be to the value of 2300 points and created using the official Mantic Companion. Lists are to be submitted to the Mantic Companion by **Sat 29th Nov 25** using the code **mOqZIE5cz1**

Tournament Reroll

Once per game a player can reroll any single die. Reroll can not be used for a "roll off" such as for first turn or to see if there's a turn 7.

What you will need

- Your 2300 point Kings of war army
- At least 1 copy of your army list, including stats for your opponent to reference.
- A copy of the Kings of War Big Red book and Clash of Kings 2025, or access to the Mantic Companion rules.
- Dice, Tape measure, measuring sticks, arc template etc.
- Chess clock or smartphone with chess clock app.
- Access to smart device with Mantic Companion installed, for score submission.

Awards

- Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- Best Painted Award
- Last Place Wooden Spoon

Sportsmanship

All the events run by Bannerhall are played to be enjoyable for everyone, therefore anyone not acting in a kind and friendly manner may be asked to leave.

Scoring

Players will be ranked using the Northern Kings Scoring System.

The number of tournament points you get from a game are decided by adding together the following three criteria:

- Win/Loss/Draw
- Kill Points Bonus
- Scenario Points

Scenarios will be decided on the day at random by the TO, but will be as per the Big Red Book/CoK25.

Mantic Companion

All players are required to have a smart device with the Mantic Companion installed, with access to at least a Free account. This will enable all lists to be submitted and validated ahead of time.

All players having access to the Mantic Companion greatly reduces the admin burden on the day for the TO, and will allow for a smoothly run event. We appreciate that not everybody has access to a smart device though, if this is the case reach out and we will submit your list for you.

Table Setup

This event will use tables 6 foot wide by 4 foot deep, with a variety of terrain on each table, detailed below.
